

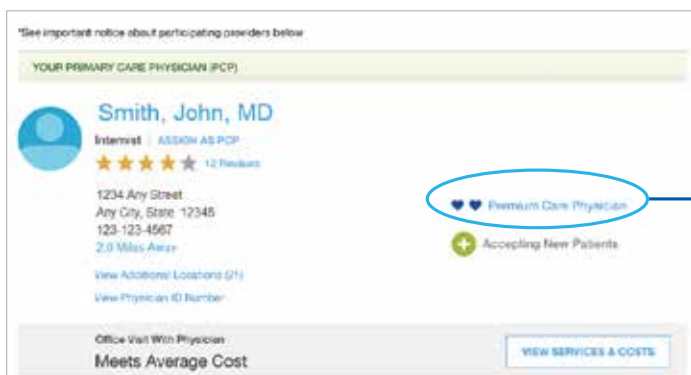


Introducing the new face of UnitedHealth Premium® Program and the expansion of Tier 1.

- Two blue hearts indicate Premium Care Physician who has met standards for both quality and cost efficiency.



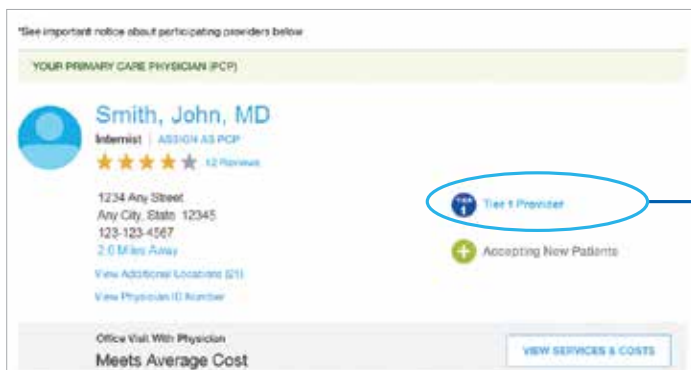
UnitedHealth Premium Program symbols look like this:
